Frida Kahlo was born in La Casa Azul (Blue House) in Coyoacán, on the outskirts of Mexico City, and lived there for most of her life It was also where she died in 1954 When Kahlo and her husband, Diego Rivera, moved there in the 1930s, they painted the walls vibrant blue and filled it with votive paintings
